### GENERAL RULES

1. All fields are neutral. Home team is determined by toss of coin.
2. No one except the manager, coaches and players listed on the roster shall occupy the dugout or be on the field during game or practice.
3. Coaches may visit with any (or all) defensive player(s), however a time is charged to the pitcher.
4. Pitcher visits:
  - a. 2 times in 1 inning- 3<sup>rd</sup> time removed
  - b. 3 times in game- 4<sup>th</sup> time removed
  - c. starts over with each pitcher
5. One offensive time out per inning is permitted. Do not hold up game to talk to batters from coaching position.
6. On deck batters are not permitted for safety reasons.
7. Runner is out if slides head first into base while advancing. May slide head first only in returning to a base.
8. Runners must slide or “avoid contact” when a play is being made on the runner. Failure to do so will result in the runner being called out.
9. No balks, however there are illegal pitches. An illegal pitch shall be called a ball.
10. After one complete inning is played, all games that do not go the legal limit (or are tied after 6 innings) are resumed from the point of stoppage. Regulation game (legal limit) is 4 innings (3 ½ if home team is winning).
11. Any game that has become regulation but is called due to weather or darkness (umpire’s discretion) is final and the score reverts back to the end of the last completed inning.
12. Teams will have the **OPTION** of batting the entire roster and thus will have

free substitution in the field throughout the game. This **OPTION** must be declared to the official scorekeeper prior to the start of the game. Should the manager elect not to bat the entire roster, the playing time rules noted below must be followed.

13. All starters and substitutes for starters must play a minimum of 3 consecutive defensive outs **and** bat at least 1 time before being removed from the game unless injury, illness, or ejection prevents this. All players must meet minimum playing time requirements (unless the game goes less than 5 1/2 innings). Violation of this rule will result in forfeiture of game. Must be protested before final out of game.
14. Any player who has been removed for a substitute may re-enter game in the SAME position in batting order provided that the substitute has met minimum playing time requirements.
15. If injury, illness or ejection causes a team to use up all eligible players then the opposing manager will select player to re-enter game. The player removed may not re-enter the game.
16. Player who arrives after the game has started does not have to meet mandatory player requirements.
17. If at the end of regulation game a team is ahead by 10 or more runs, the game must be conceded. If visiting team has a lead of 10 or more runs, the home team must be given opportunity to bat.
18. Two (2) adult base coaches are permitted. Coaches may warm up the pitcher while catcher is preparing equipment. A maximum of one (1) manager, two (2) coaches and a scorekeeper are permitted in the dugout.
19. Special pinch runner rule: Each team has the ability to special pinch run once each inning. Special pinch runner cannot be in the active lineup. Each player may only have a special pinch runner for him once in a game. **If batting the entire lineup, special pinch runner can only be the player that BATTED last in the previous offensive inning.**
20. A team must have 9 players available from their eligible roster to start a game. If 9 players are not available 10 minutes after the scheduled starting time, the game shall be considered a forfeit. A game may resume with less than 9 due to injury or illness, however an out shall be recorded every time the removed player is scheduled to bat.
21. If a player, coach or manager is ejected from a game, they are required to leave the grounds before play may resume and at the discretion of the tournament directors may not be eligible to play or coach in the next game.
22. Tie breakers for Pool play and Wild card teams are broken by: 1) Head to Head Record 2) Least Runs Against per defensive inning. 3) Most Runs Scored per offensive inning. Note: Forfeit games are considered 6-0.
23. Any team forfeiting a pool play game will be ineligible for single elimination play.

## PITCHING RULES

1. Maximum of 85 pitches per game. If the pitch limit is reached during an at-bat, the pitcher can finish pitching to that batter.
2. If the pitcher throws 1-20 pitches, no rest is required.
3. If the pitcher throws 21-40 pitches, 1 day of rest is required.
4. If the pitcher throws 41 or more pitches, 2 days rest and one game of rest will be required.
5. Illegal pitches do not count toward the pitch count.
6. Pitchers once removed from the mound may not return as the pitcher.
7. If a game is continued the following day, the same pitcher can continue but only for the maximum number of pitches allowed per game.
8. Use of an ineligible pitcher will result in forfeiture once brought to the tournament director's attention.
9. After each game, please e-mail the tournament director with your pitch counts by player (kowboyneal@yahoo.com).

## PROTESTS

1. A formal verbal protest must be made before the next play by the manager or coach to an umpire.
2. The umpire shall immediately confer with a tournament director for a decision before play resumes.
3. A violation of the playing rules is subject to forfeiture of the game.

Any rule not specifically addressed above will defer to the current years Little League Baseball "Official Regulations and Playing Rules" (Green Book).

\*\*\*All teams participating must be able to provide proof of insurance to the tournament director.  
\*\*\*Proof of player's age (age on April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2013) must also be provided upon the request of the tournament director.
