CHS Baseball Picks Up Two 7-0 Wins Against Keller, Frisco

Cowboys to Play Last District Game Tonight at Home

Last Friday night the CHS Cowboys Baseball Team took the long drive over to Keller High School and put distance between its third place District standing and Keller's fourth place rank with a shutout 7-0 win.

The Cowboys got to work with their bats early. Junior infielder Jeremy Mortensen and senior infielder Teddy Croft walked in runs with the bases loaded to grab a 2-0 lead in the top of the first inning. Junior pitcher Jake Elliot took the mound

for the Cowboys and pitched the first of seven shutout innings to hold the lead through the first.

The game went into a scoreless lull for three innings, but picked back up in the fifth. Senior outfielder Clayton Dalrymple singled to left field, and once again Mortensen and Croft scored to take a 4-0 lead.

In the sixth, Croft hit a double to run in junior infielders Tyler Jones, Tyler Zabochnik, and Mortensen. Elliot then went to the mound and once again shut down the Keller batters to make the score 7-0.

In the seventh inning there was no scoring and the game ended 7-0 with a Coppell win. Elliot pitched all seven innings, had six strikeouts and allowed no runs. With the win, Coppell holds on to its third place District standing with a 9-4 record.

The Cowboys also played a

non-District home game last Saturday against Frisco Wakeland, a 4A team who is first in its District. The game was basically a repeat of the night before, as the Cowboys won 7-0, this time with junior pitcher Austin Gardner on the mound for all seven innings. He allowed no

runs, and only three hits.

The Cowboys play their last home and District game against Keller Central tonight at 7:00 p.m. With a Coppell win tonight and a Keller Fossil Ridge loss to Keller, the Cowboys could finish the regular season ranked second.
