
Entering Scores and Pitch Counts

Managers and their designated scorekeepers can now enter both their scores and pitch counts directly in to the league web site. This will cut down on administration, and allow for immediate posting of results, and pitcher eligibility for future games.


 You'll want to begin by clicking on the SPRING TEAM SCHEDULES link in the Main Menu, on the left side of the home page:



- Next, you'll need to select your division from the drop-down menu, and your team in the next one.
- Then, click on "Report Scores":



- The next screen will present a schedule search, where you can locate the game you want to submit the score for. Select the specific date, or a date range that will return the game you're looking for.
- Then you'll need to enter the Score Reporting Password. This password will be sent directly to managers at the start of each season. Please only share this password with your official score keeper. This will ensure that the integrity of all score and pitch reporting can be maintained.




• Based on your search parameters, you'll see any/all games in the next screen. Find the game you need to report, and click on Report Score/Pitchers on the right:





- First, click on the drop-down box and change the Game Status to Completed.
- Then, record the final score for both teams
- Last, you'll need to enter the pitch totals for all players for both teams. Note that if a pitcher
 crossed a pitch threshold for days of rest/eligibility, you should also click the Finished AB (atbat) option for them as well.



• Then click Submit at the bottom of the page. You results and pitcher eligibility for both teams will be immediately available on the web site.
