



# Strasburg Willow Street Baseball Softball Association

## Failure to Comply with Standards

The terms of the **Code of Conduct** apply to ALL participants in the Strasburg Willow Street Baseball Softball Association program (players, coaches, parents, guardians and spectators). Failure to uphold or comply with the **Standards**, set forth above, will result in appropriate disciplinary actions. Failure to uphold or comply with the **Standards** will be determined by the coach and/or commissioner and/or the SWSBSA Board of Directors or related entities. Participants are not allowed to participate in any team practices, games or league activities of any kind during the suspension period and additionally may not attend as a spectator at any location at any time. Any form of contact or proximity to league activities is prohibited. In addition, any positions or titles held within SWSBSA during such suspension are forfeited. Any fines, penalties or costs imposed by SWSBSA or corresponding league organization are the personal responsibility of the participant and or their parents/guardians.

The procedures for failure to comply with the Standards set forth in this Code of Conduct include, but are not limited to, the items listed below:

**First failure to comply:** Meeting including Coach, Player and/or Parents/Guardians. A minimum one (1) game suspension will be enforced for non-physical misconduct. Any physical, violent and/or malicious misconduct will be subject to a minimum five (5) game suspension with the possibility of suspension for one calendar year from the date of misconduct.

**Second failure to comply:** Meeting including President of SWSBSA, Coach, Player and/or Parent/Guardian. A minimum three (3) game suspension for non-physical misconduct. A minimum suspension of one calendar year will be enforced for any physical, violent and/or malicious misconduct with the possibility of a lifetime ban from all SWSBSA events.

**Third Failure to comply:** Meeting including the President of SWSBSA and a minimum of two other elected SWSBSA board members, Coach, Player and/or Parents/Guardians. A minimum five (5) game suspension for non-physical misconduct with the possibility of suspension for one calendar year from the date of the third offense. Any physical, violent and/or malicious misconduct will result in a lifetime ban from all SWSBSA teams, activities and/or events.
