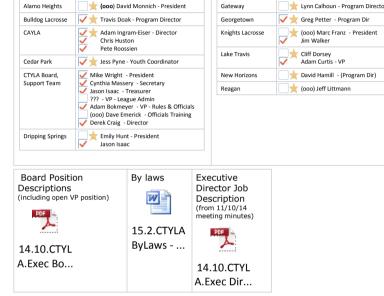

Central Texas Youth Lacrosse Association Affiliate Meeting Agenda: 9/14/2015

LEADERSHIP:

- A new CTYLA President was to be elected at the May 2015 league meeting. With no nominations at that time, the vote was put off until the September 2015 meeting and nominations were called for again. We will introduce nominees and elect a President during this meeting.
 - o Nominations: Mike Wright
 - Vote: 14 FOR, 0 AGAINST APPROVED
- In addition to the President position, the Secretary position should have been filled in May as well. We will accept nominations for this position as well. If a vote can be mode, we will elect a Secretary as well.
 - o Nominations: Cynthia Massery
 - Vote: 16 FOR, 0 AGAINST APPROVED
- Board position open: VP League & Administration
- Al Cynthia: Send VP board position R&R with minutes

AFFILIATE NEWS:

- Town & Country: Mike Warner has announced that the lacrosse program will be separating structurally from the T&C organization. Mike will introduce the new program, Texas Tomahawks Lacrosse and we will vote on their membership in the league.
 - Bush MS (Sting) dissolved, removed as member
 - Vote: Drop T&C as member, add Texas Tomahawks, 13 For APPROVED
- San Antonio programs: In addition, discussions have been ongoing throughout the summer with programs in the San Antonio area. There are new programs wishing to join the CTYLA and others that have dissolved. There's also the possibility of a boost in the S.A. league that would reduce the number of teams from that area who participate in the CTYLA.
 - SA trying to organize a league for 2016 season
 - o Current members from SA area may choose reduced/partial participation in league scrimmages, some age groups but not all
- New Facility in Round Rock: The Round Rock Chamber of Commerce has reached out to the league with partnership opportunities for their anticipated facility.
 - o City of Round Rock, facility target ready 2018, 10 fields (half turf), near Old Settlers. concessions fund raising opportunities

- RULES:

- Cross-referenced meeting notes with minutes, we've assembled a list of rules and bylaws that have been passed by vote over the past several years. Some of these rules need to be inserted into the League By-Laws, others just needed to be recorded and accessible.
- · Discussions from May:
 - "Select" Teams vs geographic/school-based registration. We have been self-policing regarding Affiliate registration but also receive complaints about players being collected from various areas to build teams. At the May meeting we asked for ideas on whether regulation was needed at the league level and ideas on how that would work.
 - We are a rec league
 - Select Team Committee: Adam Bokmeyer (committee chair), Jeff Mims, John Randolph, Erik Liberatore, Adam Ingram-Eiser, Jason Isaac, Jordan Ruggeri (requested add via email)
 - □ Do we add structure? What is penalty?
 - Al Select Team Committee, Adam B: Proposal on how to structure/manage affiliate team restrictions
 - Lightning Field. Much confusion over what was decided and what was implemented last year. Discussion and re-vote on field size.
 - ★ Lightning will be on full field per discussion
- Unnecessary roughness current rule is 3rd offense player is ejected. What happens with 4th, 5th, etc offense?

- REFEREES:

- The CTLOA (High School Ref Organization) has offered to take on/include CTYLA ref training as part of their training program.
 - CTLOA proposal: 4 days of mandatory training in Austin on weeknight, cost charged to referees similar to CTYLA, cost paid by referees attending the training, training with other CTLOA referees, no cost to CTYLA/Associations
 - Motion: Announce to CTYLA referees CTLOA training, counts toward CTYLA certification
 - □ Vote: 15 FOR APPROVED
 - o CTYLA will offer standard ref training in addition to CTLOA offering
 - CTYLA referee training is fundraiser (approx \$1,000)
- The use of the Arbiter online assignment and management program for referees.
 - For referee management (assigning, rating referees, CTLOA refs)
 - Cost ~\$700
 - Not scheduling program (MyLacrosseLeague \$1,100), would need to use another platform like LeagueAthletics (~\$400)
 - LeagueAthletics would replace <u>www.ctyla.org</u> website
 - Scheduling Website Committee: Derek Craig (committee chair), Cynthia Massery, Trey Harden
 - Al Scheduling Website Committee, Derek: Update on scheduling website options at next meeting
- We'll have updates on both and vote, if possible, on the training topic.

- ADMINISTRATOR:

- Another item held over from the May meeting was the expansion of the Exec Director role. Derek
 indicated that, looking at the length of time it takes to get proposals on items like By-Laws or the
 confusion over officer terms and existing rules, the ability to have a person committed to facilitation
 provides a functional benefit and consistency to the league.
 - o Current role: scheduling, ref scheduling, payroll
 - Expanded role: (see job description attached)
 - o Current salary \$14,000, Executive role \$28,000

Level 1: \$14.000 Annual Salary

Level 2: \$28,000 Annual Salary (Once 501c-3 status is obtained, Salary drops to \$24,000 and Director receives 10% of funds raised through sponsorships
