- 1. Voting Items:
 - A. Ref Pay and Team League Fees: Grades 1-6 \$40 (except 5/6 Red Adult Refs get \$55); Grades 7/8 \$50 for HS ref and \$55 for adult ref. Each of these numbers is a \$5 increase. Corresponding team fees: Bantam \$280 Lightning \$460, Junior \$490, Senior \$540. This is a \$20 increase at Bantam and \$40 increase at all other levels.
 - Motion: Accept team fees, league fees as indicated above Approved
 - B. Approve Rules and Waivers for 2014 Season. The NCAA rules annotated with CTYLA waivers along with a "cheatsheet" were sent out last month for review and included again with the emailing of this agenda.
 - Reviewed rules and waivers
 - Motion: Waiver to implement restart horn for Lightning and Bantam not approved
 Vote: 6 for, 9 against
 - Motion: Waiver to require elbow pads for goalies all age divisions motion did not carry
 Although motion did not carry, CTYLA recommends that all goalies wear elbow pads
- 2. Team lists due January 24th. Each Program will submit a list of teams for each age group and division. A template is attached. Email to: derek.ctyla@gmail.com
 - Average age based on age as of 9/1/2013
 - Lists must be submitted by noon on 1/24
 - Team lists not submitted by deadline will not participate in scheduling meeting
 - o Bring your team list/info to scheduling meeting for teams to use to determine competitive match ups
- 3. Referee Training Session January 18th, Time 9AM-3PM at Austin HS. Costs \$30 register at http://do.nr/e00n.
 - o Coaches can attend for free
- 4. **January 26th 12-6PM Manual Scheduling Meeting.** Location: State Capitol, Senior 12-1:30PM, Junior 1:30-3PM, Lightning 3-4:30PM and Bantam 4:30-6PM. Attendance is mandatory if your teams are playing in the league. Associations must have their field availability (time and days) and coach availability.
 - o Bring completed team list form
 - o Bring field availability schedule Sundays and some non-Sunday days (at least 2)
 - Sunday first game starts 1p
 - Programs will manage their own field usage during scheduling meeting
- 5. Season start February 23rd
 - Season: 8 games
 - o No games: weekend before and after spring break, Easter weekend
 - Season finishes first weekend of September
- 6. **Associations must submit one volunteer name either via email or at the meeting at the latest.** There are slots on a Rules Committee, Sportsmanship Committee, Jan. 26th scheduling meeting assistants, website maintenance, scheduling changes during the season assistants, referee scheduling assistant, bookkeeping assistant, and positions for assisting in drafting our operation procedures for the league (we have models from North Texas), etc.

- 7. Cheerleaders. One association has advised that they may have cheerleaders at games. Cheerleaders would be required to be on the fan side of the field located on the end that corresponds to their team's bench.
 - o Cheerleaders are considered fans and must follow same guidelines as fans
- 8. Discussion of current team estimates and impact on Red and White divisions. Discussion of proposed Pods for Bantam and Lightning.
 - Motion: Structure pool play for Red division if 14 teams submit for red Approved

- Structure of Red division will be announced before scheduling meeting, after teams have submitted their team lists
- Bantam will be organized as pods
- Lightning/Jr./Sr. Assigned a geographic region to schedule games, play 6 games in region, can play 2 outside region
