# SENIORS: NO NEW INNING AFTER 2 1/4 HOURS FROM THE SCHEDULED START TIME. JUNIORS: NO NEW INNING AFTER 2 HOURS FROM THE SCHEDULED START TIME.

NO local league rules. Regular season green book rules only.

The 'Mercy Rule' will apply as stated in the Little League rule book 4.10(e)

Bat the line- up, Continuous Batting Order (CBO), with free substitutions 4.04.

Mandatory play applies. 6 defensive outs and 1 at bat minimum. Regulation IV(i). Page 41

Official Scorebook will be at game site.

The home team will provide 1 official scorekeeper and 1 pitch counter who will sit together close to home plate as designated by the host league.

Manager, or acting manager, must have pitcher eligibility card with you prior to start of game or go get it. Game will not be delayed for lack of pitching card. Manager leaves games site until he/she has current pitch card. Manager will not be replaced while gone.

If discovered later that pitcher was not eligible, forfeit + 2 game suspension for manager.

Both teams will help with the set-up and putting away of the equipment.

Each team will furnish 2 game balls. If you ask the host league for baseballs they will charge you \$5 per. 1 adult must always be in dug-out.

**Discipline**: Each league will be responsible to take action against players, staff and parents that act in a way not becoming to Little League. If the interleague committee (District 71 rep. and 1 rep. from each league) feels that the problem was not handled properly, it will take action to correct the situation. Remember that each Leagues Board must approve all managers / coaches for each season and All-Stars so do not make the wrong impression now.

End of Season Playoffs – Top two teams from the first half and second half will advance to the playoffs. First half winner will play 2<sup>nd</sup> place of second half. Second half winner will play 2<sup>nd</sup> place of first half. Winning teams will advance to the Championship game.

Winner will be the District 71 Champion for 2019.

- Orange Book Rules will apply to all games unless indicated below.
- 2. Pre-game warm-ups will only occur if time permits.
- 3. No new inning after 1 hour and 40 minutes, finish the inning. Ties will stand. On FCLL Fields, no new inning after 1 hour and 45 minutes and "drop dead" at 2 hours.
- 4. Managers are responsible for meeting all mandatory play time for each player, 6 defensive outs and 1 at bat.
- 5. Pitching distance is 40 feet. Softball size is 12 inches.
- Each manager must carry their past pitching records. Failure to provide the pitching records will be grounds for forfeit unless agreed to by both League Presidents.
- 7. Delivery of a single pitch constitutes an inning pitched.
- 8. For every 7 innings pitched in a game, the player must have 1 calendar day of rest. The maximum number of innings a player can pitch in a game is 12.
- 9. The DROPPED 3<sup>rd</sup> strike rule is in effect.
- 10. Runners cannot leave the base until the ball leaves the pitchers hand.
- 11. Official score is kept by the home team.
- 12. Dress code: all players must be wearing a uniform identified by a number. Little League patches must be on the jerseys.
- 13. No jewelry allowed on the players except for medical alerts.
- 14. 24 hour notice must be made if a team is unable to play. Failure to notify the League Presidents will constitute a forfeit.
- 15. Good sportsmanship must be displayed at all times by players, coaches, umpires, league officials, district officials and other volunteers. It is the manager's responsibility to set the tone of the game so no taunting, cursing, or threats. Positive cheering is strongly encouraged and welcomed.
- 16. Protests may be filed based on the rule book. The protest committee will consist of the League Presidents.

- 1. Orange Book Rules will apply to all games unless indicated below.
- 2. Pre-game warm-ups will only occur if time permits.
- No new inning after 1 hour and 10 minutes, finish the inning. Ties will stand. On FCLL Fields
  game time limit is "drop dead" at 1 hour and 15 minutes. ELKS will also abide by the "drop
  dead" time.
- 4. All teams will bat their complete line-up. The 3-5-9 Rule will be observed: an inning will consistent of 3 outs or 5 runs or 9 batters, whichever comes first.
- 5. Managers are responsible for meeting all mandatory play time for each player, 6 defensive outs and 1 at bat.
- 6. Pitching distance is 30 feet. Softball size is 10 inches.
- Each manager must carry their past pitching records. Failure to provide the pitching records will be grounds for forfeit unless agreed to by both League Presidents.
- 8. Delivery of a single pitch constitutes an inning pitched.
- 9. For every 7 innings pitched in a game, the player must have 1 calendar day of rest. The maximum number of innings a player can pitch in a game is 12.
- 10. There is NO DROPPED 3<sup>rd</sup> strike rule.
- 11. Runners cannot leave the base until the ball reaches the plate.
- 12. Official score is kept by the home team.
