



## 2022-2023 Registration Form

***The purpose of this league is the development of women's ice hockey as a recreational sport in the spirit of fellowship and fair play. We are a beginner friendly, non- competitive league, please consider if this is a good fit for your playing style before registering.***

To register for the hockey season you must send a completed registration package consisting of this registration form, as well as the attached waiver and your payment. Please note the waiver must be legible and complete with a date and witness signature. Your witness can be anyone who has witnessed you reading and signing the waiver. **Goalie registration will remain at \$45.00. If you are planning to play as a player and also substitute as a goalie, you should pay the player fee only. The cost for this season will be in accordance with the following schedule:**

*\$485 payment received on or before July 15<sup>th</sup> 2022*

*\$500 payment received on or before Aug 15<sup>th</sup> 2022*

*\$515 payment received anytime after Aug 15<sup>th</sup> 2022*

We are now accepting payments via Credit Card (Visa, MC, AmEx) as well as in person Debit. Any Credit Card payments will be subject to an additional \$20 charge to cover the cost of service fees. If you wish to pay by either of these means; please contact [payments.kwwrhl@gmail.com](mailto:payments.kwwrhl@gmail.com) for assistance. Payment via cheque is still an acceptable form of payment. We will also be accepting e-transfer payments at this time and they can be sent to [payments.kwwrhl@gmail.com](mailto:payments.kwwrhl@gmail.com). Your payment must accompany your registration form. Your spot will not be confirmed until payment is made. If paying by cheque; please make payable to: 'KWWRHL' and mail your completed registration package to our Registrar:

We will accept the registration package at the year-end social event. After the social event, the registration package must be mailed and will be considered invalid if dropped off by hand unless arrangements are made with the league registrar.

### Registration Notes:

- Due to high volume of registration in past seasons, we recommend registering early. Registrations are limited and will be accepted on a first-come basis. Once the league is full, your registration will be added to the waiting list. **Teams will be drafted based on registrations received as of August 31<sup>st</sup>.** Registrations after this date will be assigned until all teams have 14 players. We cannot guarantee reciprocal requests after the team draft.
- Cheques should be dated when registration form is mailed. Post-dated cheques will not be accepted unless prior arrangement is made with the league treasurer and follow the new registration fee schedule.
- You will receive an email upon receipt of your mailed registration. This will confirm your spot in league. Please be sure your email address provided is correct. Please allow 2 weeks for processing your cheque.
- NSF cheques will cancel your registration. You will be charged \$15.00 for any NSF Fee we receive from the bank.
- Any refund requests will be assessed both a \$35.00 administration fee and the insurance fee we are charged.
- Players must be at least 21 years old and goalies must be at least 18 years old by March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023.
- Team lists and schedules will be finalized approximately 5 days prior to the start of the season. You will be contacted by a league executive member or team representative with your team name and first game details.
- Questions about the league and or the registration process can be directed to the league executive members using the contact information provided on the league website ([www.kwwrhl.ca](http://www.kwwrhl.ca))
- Please note games are played on Monday nights at Albert McCormick arena in Waterloo from 7:30-11pm and Saturday nights at Sportsworld arena in Kitchener from 5-9pm, however not every team plays every night.
- Please consider your availability to attend most games throughout the season as your registration is considered a commitment to a team sport.
- Registrants who did not play in the league during the prior year's season will be required to attend our evaluation night. You will be notified by email from our executive team with details.

- Accept that no individual or team has the right to represent the league in and form of communication without Executive Committee approval

- I understand that I cannot register for this league and a competitive association/ League for the same season (goalies exempted);
- I have read the registration notes attached to this application;
- I understand the KWWRHL occasionally takes photographs of its members participating in league activities. By signing this waiver, I am agreeing to allow the KWWRHL to use my photographic image in forms of media, including printed materials and websites. Any Video recording of league games/events must be requested in advance to League Executive and approval must be received.
- I have read and understand the above and voluntarily agree to the terms of this waiver and release of liability.

### **Goaltender Policy (where applicable):**

- Notice for cancellation of any scheduled game requires 24 hours notice. (Cancellation must be received at the latest by 9am on a Sunday for a Monday night game and 9am on Fridays for a Saturday night game)
- You are allowed one emergency/ last minute cancellation in the season. A second last minute cancellation results in a warning letter. A third last minute cancellation will result in a one game suspension for your assigned team (if applicable). You will not be eligible to play until this suspension is served. A fourth last minute cancellation will result in a one game suspension for your assigned team (if applicable) as well as a \$40.00 fine. Again, you will not be eligible to play until this suspension is served and the fine is paid.
- Any further disciplinary action due to last minute cancellations will be at the discretion of the executive committee in consultation with the Goalie Coordinator.
