2016 Travel Tryouts

Registration is required and must be completed by July 20th 2015

The Marlboro Mustangs Baseball Travel Club will be holding tryouts for the upcoming 2016 fiscal season that runs August 1, 2015 through July 31st 2016. Our goal is to establish and develop baseball teams comprised of Marlboro Little League players that will compete in travel baseball leagues along with tournament play. We're looking for talented Little Leaguers who are committed to becoming better players.

For those players that are selected, we offer a multi-tiered approach to player development. The program consists of a fall season, winter training program, a spring travel league (which runs concurrent with the Little League program) and a series of summer tournaments.

We strive to establish two teams (Gold & Blue) for each age group. Should there be additional talented ball players in an age group, we will consider creating a third (White) team. Tryouts will consist of a series of baseball drills. Player selection will include multiple points of information including little league, travel ratings and tryout ratings.

This program requires players to attend all practices and games. Parents are expected to actively participate in fundraising events that benefit both the Marlboro Baseball Travel Club and Marlboro Little League.

Tryout ages, dates, and times (field location TBD) – report to the Old Kitchen at MLL complex for check-in.

Playing age is determined as of April 30th 2016.

Important Notes:

- All players for the New 7U through and including the New 11U age groups who wish to be considered for the 2016 teams must attend these tryouts, whether you are currently on a Mustang team or not. Existing Mustang team players that move into the New 12U & Up age groups for 2016 are not required to attend these tryouts.
- Please bring all equipment needed (bat, glove, catcher's gear etc.) to the tryout and dress for baseball, which includes protective gear such as a cup and heart guard and baseball pants (no shorts).
- If you are a current or former Marlboro Travel Player you are not to wear your Mustangs uniform, which includes hat, uniform shirt, practice t-shirt, etc. If all you have is a Mustang helmet, that is allowed, we would not ask anyone to buy a new helmet for the tryout, but if you own another helmet please use that. If you have another equipment bag, please use it, if not your Mustangs bag is also ok. If you wear your Mustangs uniform you will be turned away or asked to change. Please also do not wear a shirt with your name on the back or a LL All-Star Jersey.
- Independent raters who are not part of the Marlboro Travel Club will score the players.
- Tryouts will begin within 30 minutes of check-in and last approximately 2 hours
