

The Fairview Baptist Mission, a mission of First Baptist Church of Bonham, became Trinity Baptist Church with a dedication service on May 8th, 1955.

The property was purchased as its current location at the corner of Denison and Franklin Streets for \$700.00. The first building was an old barracks of the Jaque Power Saw Company. In 1954, a larger building was moved from Jones Field to add additional space. The charter membership numbered eighty-nine and the annual budget was eighteen thousand dollars.

The church building has been expanded twice, adding a new sanctuary in March 1977 and classrooms and a fellowship hall in November 1992.

The first Pastor, Bro. M. H. Koonce, led the church from May to November 1955. Other Pastors that have served Trinity are: Harrison Johns, Alvin Robinson, J P. Skinner, Thomas Beall, Joe Eubanks, Don Christian, Bob Posey, Stephen Patterson, Roy Oats, Rick Shulze and currently Henry Shelton.
