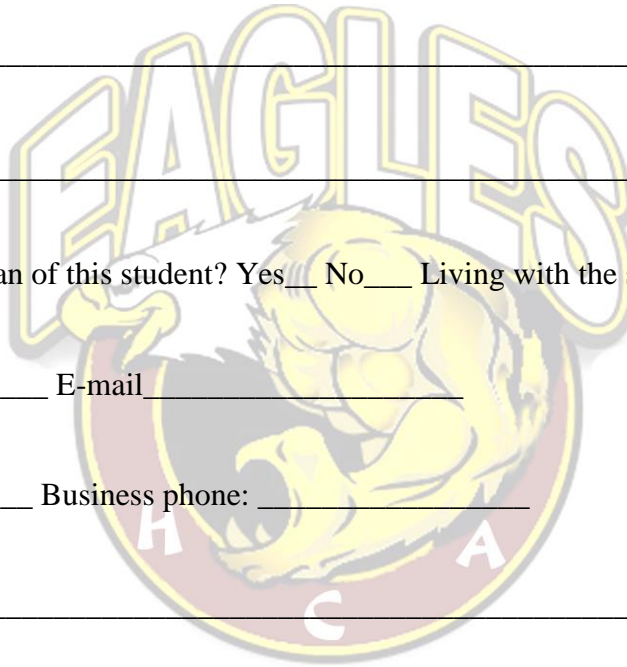

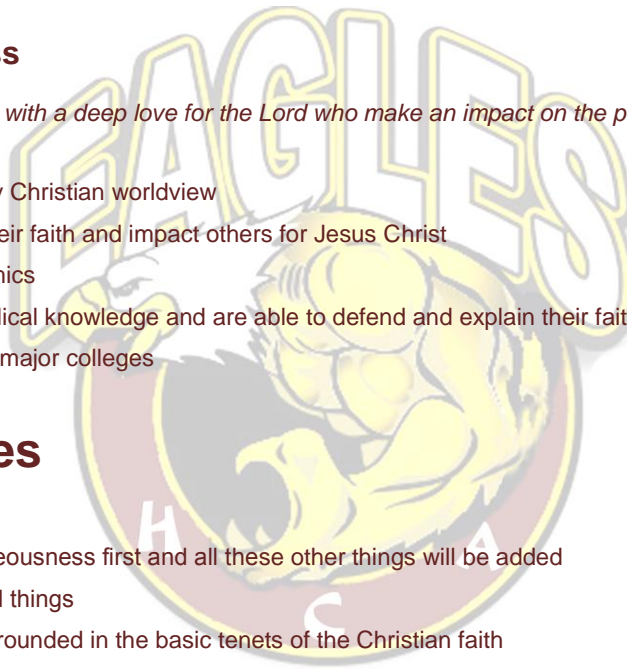

I would like to thank you for your interest in Harvest Christian Academy. Enclosed are an application, standards of conduct, and additional information to help you become more familiar with our school.

HCA admits qualified students of any race, color, biological gender,, or ethic origins to all rights, privileges, programs, and activities. Students are accepted on academic and behavioral probations for the first semester.

HCA is not equipped nor has teachers specially trained to facilitate children with certain medical conditions, learning disabilities or with ADD/ADHD. If students' diagnosed with these conditions are accepted in our school, it is the parents' responsibility to provide services other than what classroom teachers would do within the classroom.

Step 1- to apply, the following must be completed and supplied to the school office:

- A complete student application (K and 1st grade students must be 5, or 6 years of age respectively before Sept 1)
- Student's most current report card (not applicable for K)
- Students most current achievement test scores
- Copy of student's' birth certificate
- Copy of any educational, psychological, medical testing (if applicable)
- \$50.00 non-refundable application fee (per student), plus registration fee once accepted

Step 2- you will be contacted to set up an interview time after the following have been received:

- Reference forms from student's church and/or school
- Test results, report card/Transcript

Step 3 – You will be contacted to schedule an interview with you and the students by our administrators.

Please be prepared by reading and becoming familiar with the following:

- Student Handbook/ Standard of Conduct
- Sample HCA contract Agreement

Step 4- After your interview, you will be contacted by letter regarding the completion of the step four in the application process. Below is a list of forms that are to be in the student's file before you will be sent an official acceptance letter.

- Certificate of immunization
- Student enrollment forms
- Contract Agreement
- Official School transcript Release Form

A student will be officially enrolled and may begin school, only when all the above steps are completed.

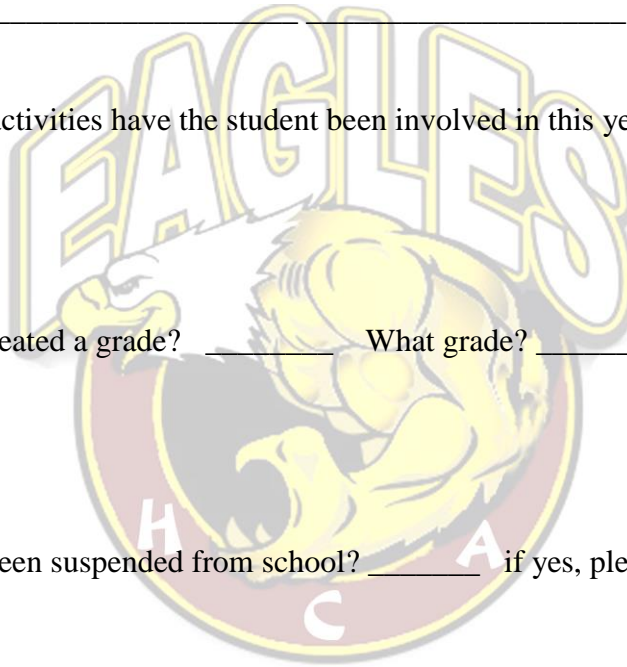
