Benefits and Blessings of Separation

The theme of separation throughout the Bible is to belong to God. To become His, His children, His heirs and His inheritance. Leviticus 20:26 tells us "And ye shall be holy unto me: for I the LORD am holy, and have severed you from other people, that ye should be **mine**."

Our separation activates our benefits and blessings. As we seek and absorb His holiness, it will naturally exude from our speech, our behavior, our attitudes and our dress. It becomes **our relationship of love and devotion to God** and His towards us.

Our separation from the world positions us in the family of God to receive all **of the benefits available from God**. Psalms 103 lists a few of his benefits:

- *Forgives all my iniquities*
- *Heals all my diseases*
- *Redeems my life from destruction*
- *Crowns me with loving kindness and tender mercies*
- *Satisfies my mouth with good things*

Psalms 91 talks of being separated in the secret place of the Most High, abiding under the shadow of the Almighty. Here are some **blessings of being separated in Him**:

- *He shall deliver me from the snare*
- *Will not be afraid for the terror of the night or arrow by day*
- *He shall give His angels charge over you to keep you in all thy ways*
- *You will call Him, He will answer*
