

31% don't have a church home.

Of these—

- ■21% come from a Presbyterian background
- ■16% have never been a member of any church
- ■49% are there because someone invited them
- ■57% already have a friend in the congregation
- ■58% believe all different religions are equally good
- ■46% say denomination is not important
- ■24% say the church they went to did not follow up and invite them back.
- ■Most will visit 1 to 3 churches before choosing a new home
- ■The top 3 reasons for returning: (1) friendliness of the people, (2) quality of the sermon, and (3) overall worship experience.

What people are seeking

- ■75% are looking for ways to live a meaningful life
- ■56% want to make a difference in the world
- ■20% have a sense of what God wants them to do with their life
- ■72% of women say they hav too much stress in their life
- ■42% of moms say faith communities offer them no emotional or social support

What people are feeling

- ■64% of Protestants feel they have personal responsibility to share their faith
- Evangelism is significantly on the rise only among millennials
- Born-again millennials evangelize more than any other generation today.
