Do you know that the “1001” grant program is retooled? The funding arm of the Presbyterian Mission Agency that helps establish New Worshipping Communities is revising its “1001”

grant program to better serve the movement. The “Seed Grant” provides an initial \$7,500 to help start a 1001 community. After a year, the ministry can apply for an additional \$25,000 “Investment Grant.” The ministry would have the opportunity to apply for a \$25,000 “Growth Grant” 18 months later. Both of the grants require dollar matching from a mid-council, congregation or in kind support. All new worshipping community leaders are still eligible to apply for a Health Insurance Grant worth \$1,500 per year—twice renewable. Since the 1001 movement began in July of 2012, Mission Program Grants has given out 162 \$7,500 “Seed Grants” - originally designed for the first six months of ministry - and 40 \$17,500 “Investment Grants.” (From “‘1001’ grant program is retooled” by Paul Seebeck in The Presbyterian Outlook, November 24, 2014)

Do you know who received the 2014 PW grants from the Fellowship of the Least Coin? The Fellowship of the Least Coin (FLC) is a prayer movement. When women pray for justice, peace and reconciliation, FLC asks that they set aside the least coin of their country for the support of women and children around the world. In more than 80 countries, women are in solidarity through prayer and their least coins. Grants are distributed through the International Committee for the Fellowship of the Least Coin (ICFLC) to individual projects, as well as to church conferences and organizations. ICFLC also distributes scholarships for young women and emergency grants for disaster relief. The following project grants awarded are: Africa—\$33,200; Caribbean—\$10,000; Europe—\$20,000; Latin America—\$15,000; Middle East—\$15,000; North America—\$10,000; Pacific—\$20,000; World Day of Prayer International Committee—\$10,000; Block Grants to Ecumenical Organizations—\$110,000; and Recipients of FLC Scholarship Award for Young Women—\$5,800 (recipients are in Thailand, India and the Philippines). The two \$5,000 grants

awarded in North America are to Fostering a Dream Fund: A project of Covenant to Care for Foster Children, a ministry of the Cape Cod Council of Churches, Inc., United States of America, and Young Women’s Leadership Experience at the United Nations Commission on the Status of Women, United States of America.
