The changes have been made on the black and white designs for your window and we have had them photographed. These are:

2. Top of staff modified.
3. Saw in ventilator section replaced with anvil and sword being beaten into ploughshare.
4. Shell redrawn and redefined.
9. Dorm of tomb changed. Jars of spices and grave clothes added at base. Neck of phoenix shortened.
11. Chalice replaced by pitcher - shaped "earthen vessel." Prison bars introduced into background.
12. Symbols of professions included: lamp and books-education, torch- social services, tools and gears - labor, spade- agriculture, caduceus with cross top, mortar and pestle- medicine and science, lyre- the arts. Two clasped hands, one brown and one white are in Ventilator.

The center part of the rose window has been redesigned to show the new created earth. We have had a new lumiere made of this which is enclosed.

By the way, we still haven't gotten the signed contract.
