ALISTER

JENNY

The first thing I'm going to do is call my mother. She'll be so relieved.

ALISTER

You will see him, though.

JENNY

No, no. I don't see him all that often.

She's stopped short upon seeing one of her paintings.

ALISTER

It'll be lonely here...without you.

JENNY

I do want you to come to London, really. It could be so much better for you.

ALISTER

JENNY

ALISTER

JENNY

No! No! Help!!

She tries to escape but everything is locked. He slowly stands from the table.

JENNY (CONT'D)

I stayed the four weeks.

ALISTER

I just have to have you here a little longer.

JENNY

Why? What more can I do? What more do you want?

ALISTER
