INT. BOAT SUPPLY STORE - DAY

Mac and Dennis meet in the middle of the store.

MAC

Hey, buddy. I got some turpentine, some wax and some high-gloss boat paint, this shit is really expensive.

DENNIS

Ah, yeah, you're telling me. I picked us up some new slacks and Docksiders so we have the right look and fit in and everything... We're running pretty low on money, though.

MAC

Plus we've gotta fill that thing up with gas...

DENNIS

I know, we gotta pop by the department store to pick up the mattress, and I wanna get a nice one, too... You know?

MAC

Wait, the... The mattress? What do we need a mattress for?

DENNIS

What do you mean what do we need a mattress for? Why the hell do you think we just spent all that money on a boat? The whole purpose of buying the boat in the first place is to get the ladies nice and tipsy top-side so we can take them to a nice, comfortable place below-deck, and you know, they can't refuse... Because of the implication.

MAC

Oh, uh... Okay... Yeah, you had me going there for the first part, but the second half kinda threw me.

DENNIS

Well, dude, think about it. She's out in the middle of nowhere with some dude she barely knows.

(MORE)

DENNIS (CONT'D)

You know, she looks around and what does she see? Nothing but open ocean.

(In woman's voice)

"Ah, there's nowhere for me to run! What am I gonna do, say no?"

Dennis shakes his head.

MAC

(Beat)

Okay...

They both laugh a little.

MAC (CONT'D)

Yeah... That seems really dark, though.

DENNIS

No, it's not dark. You're misunderstanding me, bro.

MAC

Okay, yeah, I think I am.

DENNIS

Yeah, you are. Because if the girl said no, then the answer obviously is no.

MAC

Right.

DENNIS

But the thing is that she's not gonna say no. She would never say no because of the implication.

Mac stops laughing and looks uncomfortable.

MAC

Now, you've said that word implication a couple of times... What implication?

DENNIS

The implication that things might go wrong for her if she refuses to sleep with me. Now, not that things are gonna go wrong for her, but she's thinking that they will. MAC

(Beat)

But it sounds like she doesn't want to have sex with you -

DENNIS

Why aren't you understanding this this?

MAC

-- I don't --

DENNIS

She doesn't know whether she wants to have sex with me, that's not the issue --

MAC

Are you gonna hurt women?

DENNIS

I'm not gonna hurt these women. Why would I ever hurt these women?! You're not getting this at all --

MAC

I'm not getting it.

DENNIS

God damn...

They notice an elderly lady suspiciously eyeing them.

DENNIS (CONT'D)

Don't you look at me like that, you certainly wouldn't be in any danger.

MAC

So these women are in danger --

DENNIS

Nobody's in any danger! How can I make that any more clear to you?! It's the implication of danger.

Mac still isn't convinced. Dennis angrily sighs.

DENNIS (CONT'D)

You know what, let's just drop it --

MAC

Yeah, we'll drop it.

DENNIS

Just buy your shit and let's get out of here.
