3. Context

As approved at the November 19th, 2015, Board of Directors' meeting and after an update at the Board of Directors' meeting of April 28th 2016, the NCC took an active role in Canada's sesquicentennial celebrations in 2017 by:

- Initiating meaningful legacy initiatives, leveraging the NCC's real property assets and planning functions;
- Inviting the public to experience rarely accessible properties.

The legacy initiatives were regrouped in the three following areas of activities:

1. Planning the Capital:
 - a. Plan for Canada's Capital: 2017-2067;
 - b. Capital Illumination Plan: 2017-2027.
2. Beautifying the Capital, and;
3. Confederation Pavilions.

Furthermore, the NCC facilitated partner's initiatives by providing:

4. Timely Federal Approvals and;
5. Permits for major events on NCC lands in 2017.
