TWO SUSPECTED STORAGE FACILITY BURGLARS ARRESTED

On Thursday, January 10, 2019 at approximately 7:30 pm, El Segundo Police Officers saw a suspicious male walking inside of the Public Storage Facility located at 1910 Hughes Way. The officers observed the male break into a storage unit by using a pair of bolt cutters to cut the lock. Officers detained the male as he was exiting and carrying property believed to have just been stolen from the storage unit. During the contact, officers discovered he had a substance resembling methamphetamine and a glass pipe commonly used to smoke methamphetamine.

An examination of the storage unit the male broke into revealed he had attempted to break through the wall of the unit so he could gain access to the adjacent storage space as well. The male was in possession of suspected stolen property.

Further investigation revealed a suspected female accomplice was parked nearby as a lookout and/or getaway driver. Inside of the vehicle officers located additional suspected burglary tools including another set of bolt cutters

Wilson Giron (26) and Melany Garza (21), both residents from the City of Hawthorne, were arrested on the suspicion of committing multiple crimes including burglary, possession of burglary tools and possession of methamphetamine.
