Important Notice from Atlantic City Electric Start of Reliability Project & Expected Traffic Delays

Atlantic City Electric has commenced construction on a \$25 million project to assure continued safe, reliable and affordable energy service for our customers. We are replacing more than 8 miles of existing electric transmission line and installing other modern electric devices in Winslow Township along Williamstown/New Freedom Road and in Monroe Township on Sicklerville Road.

This work requires roadside access to our facilities, which unavoidably will result in traffic delays through Mid-April. Construction work hours will be 8:30AM till 3:30PM on weekdays and 7AM-5PM on weekends. **On Saturday, February 9 there will also be a detour in effect from 7AM till 5PM. Rain-day for detour is Sunday, February 10th.**
