



John 1:43-46

Discuss

Jesus is relentless in pursuing us because He wants a relationship with us and wants what's best for us.

Jesus intentionally found Philip and invited him to follow Him. Philip's "yes" changed the rest of his life.

• What "yeses" have changed your life?

Philip was so excited about Jesus he invited Nathanael to meet Jesus for himself.

Jesus found Philip. Philip found Nathanael. Found people find people.

- Who invited you to the place where you met Jesus?
- Did that person's excitement about Jesus influence how you saw Him? Why?

We all know people, like Nathanael, who are skeptical about church and God.

- Have you talked about Jesus with people you know are skeptical about God, church and faith?
- How did they respond?

Challenge: Do whatever it takes to get people here this coming Sunday. We're going to explain the good news about Jesus and invite people to commit to following Him!

Who will you invite to NewSpring for this coming Sunday's message?

If you're a Christian, Jesus found you and pursued you. Most likely, He pursued you through someone else.

• Has God ever told you to bring someone to church or talk with him or her about Jesus? What happened?

Jesus changes our lives. He wants to use us to pursue other people so their lives can be changed, too.
