



## SCENIC 6A TWO-WHEELING THROUGH TOWN

Destinations: Jomamas, Brewster General Store, Seaweeds, The Strawberry Patch, Great Cape Organic Farm and Cyber Café, The Brewster Bookstore

You heard right! Those cute shops dotting Route 6A are calling your name. Biking is the best way to see them and explore this quaint historic village. Here are a couple of our favorite local hotspots. After May, many are open daily, and after Labor Day in September, many are open weekends only. Please call in advance if you have your heart set on a stop.

Remember its ok – preferable even – to use the sidewalks on these local excursions. Just pedal slowly and make way for pedestrians.

Jumpstart at [Jomamas](#)

Start your bike ride and morning off right with a breakfast sip at Jomamas (2740 Main St. | 774.323.0719). Open 7am-4pm daily. Continue down Villages Drive to Route 6a, and take a right at the end of Villages Drive. Jomamas is up ahead on the right. Big front porch, delightful adirondack chairs – you can't miss it! Jomamas offers an eclectic selection of healthy and delicious soul-nurturing foods, including coffee every way, breakfast and lunch sandwiches, and NY bagels baked fresh every morning and throughout the day. Hang out on the front porch and sip on a latte. What a way to begin a Cape Cod morning!

Cure your sweet tooth and hop on over to [Hopkins House Bakery](#) (2727 Main St. | 508.896.3450) right across the street serving up scones, brownies and cookies. Open on season only, Thursday through Sunday, 8am – 4pm.

Now you are ready for some serious sidewalk biking right to the General Store. Continue 1.7 miles, and you'll see [The Brewster General Store](#) (1935 Main St. | 508.896.3744). Yes, it's as authentically charming inside as it is on the outside. Take

your time exploring every nook and cranny of this legendary we-have-it-all gem: old-fashioned candy, lobster crackers, dish towels, maps, toys, groceries, even tin lunch boxes. Grab an ice cream cone and hang out on the benches in front. We strongly recommend the fudge. Open Thurs. through Sat. 6am-6pm, Sun. 6am-5pm.

Don't miss [The Strawberry Patch](#), which is temporarily located in the upstairs of the General Store. A sister to the Brewster General Store, its merchandise is arts-and-crafty.

Hop back on your bikes and head back toward Ocean Edge Resort. On the right side of 6A, pedal a short distance to [The Brewster Bookstore](#) (2648 Main St. | 508.896.6543). Need a great book recommendation? The well-read staff loves to help. This independent bookstore boasts a terrific kids' selection. Plus the card, toy, and gift selections in back will entertain kids and adults alike.

Just a little further down the road, grab a pick-me-up beverage at Snowy Owl Coffee Roasters (2624 Main St. | 774.323.0605). The welcoming atmosphere and fresh aroma will be just the thing to get you through the day.
