A Makerspace is a general space that can be used for many different things. 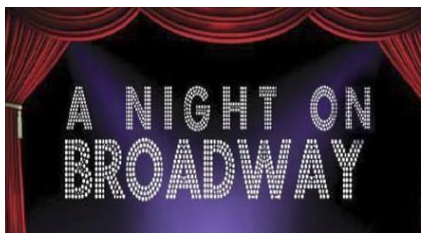
## Faith Community Nurses

Your PHUMC Faith Community Nurses remind you to enjoy the sun, but do it wisely. Please remember to:

- use sunscreen and protective clothing together.
- reapply sunscreen (even waterproof and water-resistant varieties) regularly, especially after swimming.
- Don't count on sunscreen to provide complete protection, wear a wide-brimmed hat to reduce the sun's rays to the face, head and neck.
- reduce your time in the sun, especially from 10 a.m.-4 p.m. when the sun's rays are the strongest.
- protect your eyes with proper sunglasses. Sunlight reflecting off sand and water intensifies exposure to UV rays, increasing your risk of developing eye problems such as cataracts. Look for a label that offers 99-100% UV protection and polarized is an even added bonus.

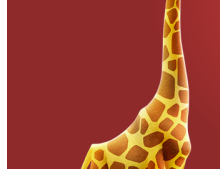

-If you leave the Sanctuary with your child, feel free to do so, but please come back! As Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me." A Family Room is located behind the HISkidz Check In station and allows for you to see and hear the service.

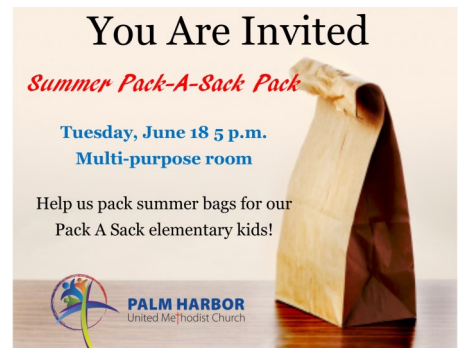
