2019 Florida Annual Conference Report

Our theme this year was "On Mission Together". We heard many inspiring speakers who brought a message of unity and how to be "on mission together".

The Ordination, Commissioning and Licensing of 56 people, including Jonathan McGurley, our missionary in Japan.

We now have 301 Fresh Expressions in Florida! The Goal is 500 by 2025. Gary and I experienced two of the Fresh Expressions on Thursday night. 15 churches celebrated milestone anniversaries from 50-175 years, including Curlew UMC /150 yrs. Only 3 churches were closed this year.

The election of our 2020 General and Jurisdictional Conference Delegations - led by Alex Shanks for clergy delegates and Molly McEntire for lay delegates.

We enthusiastically approved a new ministry plan for Latino/Latina ministries.

We engaged in dialogue about our church's social teaching and our duty to be a good steward of the Earth in regard to plastic and foam products.

We approved funding for seminary scholarships for the next five years.

Over \$37,000 given to the Bishop's Offering in order to start a new church within the Lowell Women's Correctional Institute in Reddick and the revitalization of FAMU Wesley in Tallahassee.
