Atrium

The Atrium can be used for a standing reception, seated dinner, presentation or dancing, with capacity for 50 to 450 people depending on the type of event and set up. Because we are open to the public until 5 pm, the Atrium is available for evening events starting at 6:30 or 7 pm.

Rental price includes standard tables and chairs, set up and break down and museum security, maintenance and event staff.
