

Rupert Murdoch put his \$38m New York town home in West Village on the market

News Corp executive chairman Rupert Murdoch has put his New York town house on the market for \$US28.9 million (\$A38m) after his March wedding to former model Jerry Hall.

The four-level West Village home with views of the Empire State building to the north and One World Trade Centre to the south features a full floor master suite on the third level.

The circa 1850's Greek Revival-style townhouse, across the street from actress Sarah Jessica Parker's new home, has four bedrooms in total and is topped with a limestone paved roof terrace.
