

About 1 in 4 Indians perceive a lack of tenure security, with Tamil Nadu, Telangana and Kerala having the highest levels of insecurity.




02 DOCUMENTATION

1 in 4 Indians do not possess any formal documents to prove ownership or use-rights over their property.











03 PROPERTY PROTECTION


48% of Indians think property rights are well protected in the country, while only 17% think they are not well protected.


05 TENURE SECURITY BY TENURE TYPE

Methodology A nationally representative sample of 16,475 adults 18 years or older were asked about their perceptions and experiences with property rights and tenure security in India between August and September 2017.
