PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

Before me this date personally appeared Lavandowski Richard William who being first duly sworn deposes and says that on the 3 day of Jan. 1983 at 30 Ne 28 Ave. Pompano Boh.

the above named defendant committed the above offenses charged and the facts showing probable cause to believe same are as follows:

At approximately 1000 hrs the undersigned investigator was notified by Sgt Aldeman that approximately \$25,000 in sword fish along with a refer truck value had been removed from 30 ne 28 Ave on 2115 hrs 1-2-83. The owner of the fish and truck stated that he had advised the local Seafood wholesalers of the stolen fish at approximately 0800 hrs 1-3-83. The owner recieved a call from a witness Kaelbel stating that the subject along with two co defendants had been at the Rowanda Seafood at 2635 N. Riverside dr Pompano Boh and sold approximately 1000 lbs of the fish for \$2700.00. The white P/U truck and the discription was given to the undersigned and Ft. Laud. was contacted. The undersigned and Ft. Laud. Det. Ives responded to 1121 NE 7 Ave. Kaelbel Wholesalers and set up a surv. of the business. At approximately 1345 hrs the subjects drove up to the business and made contact with thw witness Kaelbel and transacted the sale of the fish with him. The undersigned and Det. Ives observed the vehicle and subjects drive up back into the building and unload the fish. The subjects recieved a check for the amount of \$12,609.90 for the Fish from the witness. The subjects were then followed by the undersigned and Det. Ives along with the aide of the Ft. Lauderdale airplane known as "Papa" #1. The subject left went to I-95 northbound and exited the roadway at Yamato Rd. The truch with some of the fish had been located by Boca PD in the area of 6000 N St Andrews Blvd an isolated area mostly farm land. Boca PD had units waiting for the subjects. As the subjects entered the area of the stolen truck they observed th the undersigned and Det. Ives following and fled northbound. The subjects were stopped by the under signed and Det Ives with the aide of marked Boca Units following. The defendant and the co defendant were TOT Boca PD Palm Boh Ct. The subjects were charged with theft in Palm Boh Ct. The subjects were read thier rights and the subjects gave worn statements as th thir involvement in the theft.
