This is in response to your request of September 22, 2008, under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552 for a copy of the report entitled, "An Evaluation of Alhurra television programming, conducted for the Broadcasting Board of Governors by the University of Southern California Center on Public Diplomacy at the Annenberg School, University of Southern California," dated July 31, 2008.
