Dear Ms. Walker:

The employer/carrier has controverted Mr. Marshall's further entitlement to compensation and medical care apparently on the basis that he failed to appear for two defense medical evaluations scheduled by the employer/carrier.

Based upon the attached evidence provided by Mr. Marshall he had clearly advised the employer/carrier of a scheduling conflict related to his 2/24/09 appointment with Dr. Knoebel and that appointment was cancelled. In addition, an email from Kari Malone, Sr. Medical Case Manager, to Mr. Marshall, dated 2/24/09 stated that "per the industrial carrier's request, the rescheduled IME evaluation with Dr. Knoebel for March 4, 2009 has been canceled".

In addition it appears that the employer/carrier has indicated that Mr. Marshall has failed to pursue prescribed medical care. However, the medical records you provided clearly support that the on 2/4/09 the claimant was advised by Jeffrey Smith M.D. to discontinue formal physical therapy (see attached).

In consideration of the above there would appear to be no basis for the employer/carrier to have terminated Mr. Marshall's entitlement to compensation and medical treatment. Medical treatment as well as compensation fro temporary total disability at the rate of \$812.77 per week should be reinstated retroactive to 3/17/07 and continuing.

You are requested to respond within 10 days.
