At the beginning of the award period, what was the number of backlogged DNA cases? --- Fifty three (53) DNA cases were in backlog at the beginning of this award period (September 30, 2006).
At the end of the current quarterly reporting period, what was the number of CODIS hits attributable to forensic analyses funded under this grant award? --- Zero (0) CODIS hits were attributable to forensic analysis funded under this grant during the fourth quarter of 2007.
At the end of the current quarterly reporting period, what was the number of backlogged DNA cases? --- One hundred and fifty six (156) DNA cases were in backlog at the end of the fourth quarter of 2007.
At the end of the current quarterly reporting period, what was the number of forensic DNA profiles entered into CODIS as the result of funds provided under this grant award? --- 21 profiles were entered into CODIS during the fourth quarter of 2007. Two profiles were entered as a result of funds from this grant. The two (2) profiles were from sexual assault cases.
