
Settled Agreement of the parties, be and the same is hereby rescinded nunc pro tunc April 27, 2007.



The Agency for Health Care Administration, Bureau of Field Operations, has inspected Manatee Palms Youth Services and has determined the conditions that resulted in the placement of a moratorium against the facility on April 27, 2007, have been corrected.
