

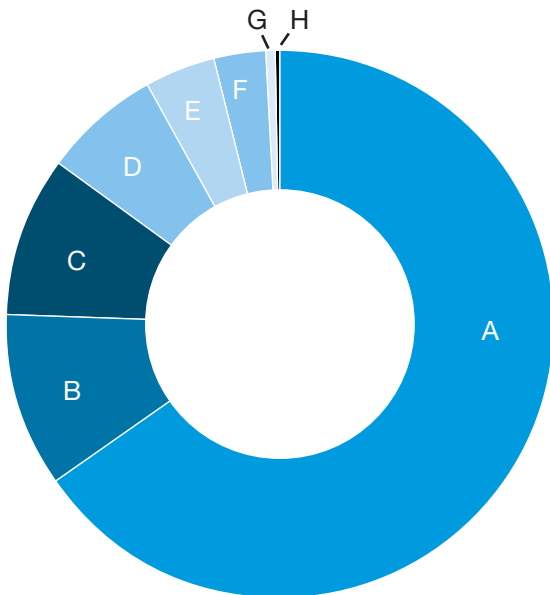
# 2015–2016 ACADEMIC YEAR
