

PARDON

TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, between July of 2009 and February of 2013, in the Criminal and General Sessions Courts for Davidson County, Tennessee, Joshua Hunt was convicted of possession (case nos. GS446638, SC874608, SC874609, SC895742, and GS510372); paraphernalia (case nos. GS10371 and SC939369); and the sale of controlled substances (case no. 2012-B-1898); and

WHEREAS, Tennessee's constitution and statutory law authorize the governor to grant executive clemency, including the power to issue pardons; and

WHEREAS, this case appears to me to be a proper one for the exercise of executive elemency because Mr. Hunt has demonstrated exemplary citizenship since the completion of his sentences, as well as a compelling reason for a pardon.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by Article III, Section 6, of the Tennessee Constitution and by the laws of the State of Tennessee, do hereby grant a pardon in favor of Mr. Hunt, pardoning him for his convictions listed above.
