

## **PARDON**

## TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, in March of 1998, in the Criminal Court for Davidson County, Tennessee, Tyree Morgan was convicted of one count of sale of less than 0.5 gram cocaine (case no. 97-0-2301); and in November of 2000, in the Criminal Court for Davidson County, Tennessee, Mr. Morgan was convicted of one count of felony weapon possession (case no. 2000-I-1051); and

WHEREAS, Tennessee's constitution and statutory law authorize the governor to grant executive clemency, including the power to issue pardons; and

WHEREAS, this case appears to me to be a proper one for the exercise of executive elemency because Mr. Morgan has demonstrated exemplary citizenship since the completion of his sentences, as well as a compelling reason for a pardon.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by Article III, Section 6, of the Tennessee Constitution and by the laws of the State of Tennessee, do hereby grant a pardon in favor of Mr. Morgan, pardoning him for his convictions listed above.
