
Winter 2018: Technology on the Edge

Manuscript submissions due by July 20

AAMI will devote the winter 2018 edition of its award-winning journal supplement, *Horizons*, to the topic of **technology on the edge**. The publication will explore innovative technology in development (e.g., wearables, artificial intelligence, virtual reality) and combination products, as well as look at the regulation and standardization of these novel technologies—among other topics.


Manuscript areas of focus can include, but are not limited to:

- Analysis of technology that has recently started having—or is about to have—a real-world impact, including wearables, combination products, at-home diagnostics, innovations in software, robotics, advancements in 3D printing, and applications of virtual reality and artificial intelligence.
- Use of on-the-edge technologies, such as simulation and virtual reality, in designing devices, evaluating human factors considerations, and training clinicians and healthcare technology management (HTM) professionals.
- How the regulatory environment and standards development will need to advance to keep stride with changing technologies.
- How game-changing technologies will affect the field of HTM and other areas of healthcare.



Submission categories include the following:

- **Research** articles based on scientific method or scholarly investigation
- Systematic **reviews** reflecting bodies of knowledge in relevant areas
- **Case studies** describing valuable real-world experiences or practice innovations
- **Tools-based papers** detailing emerging methods, measures, and instruments
- **Commentaries** expressing informed opinions about events, trends, and/or developments



The contents of *Horizons* are indexed and searchable on various healthcare and scientific databases, including PubMed.
