IASP Public Comment Policy

All comments are subject to the guidelines below. If these guidelines are not followed, your submission may not be reviewed.

Comments that include the following are prohibited:

- Vulgar, obscene, profane, threatening, or abusive language; personal attacks of any kind; attacks on the organization
- Language that is discriminatory (including hate speech) based on race, national origin, age, gender, sexual orientation, religion, or disability, etc.
- Endorsements of commercial products, services, organizations, companies, etc.
- Repetitive posts (please only submit one comment per person)
- Spam or undecipherable language
- Copyright infringement
- Solicitation of funds
- Comments not relevant to the comment topic
- Information or disclosure of patient information that could violate HIPAA
- Industry input that not accompanied by a corresponding disclosure information

All comments should be respectful and relevant to the specific topic.
