There has been an inordinate amount of time spent debating the concept of coming to Jesus "just as you are." This debate stems from a crucial misunderstanding of Scripture and an open mishandling of the teachings of Christ. While there is no doubt that Christ encouraged His disciples to simply follow Him, there is sincere doubt that Christ allowed them to remain "just as they were." This morning, I pray that we examine this dangerous teaching and can remove any concerns or questions that we might have about God's teaching on this oft-used phrase.

Some might ask how this affects us today since we do not believe this as a phrase to build our belief/faith on? Sadly, it has infiltrated the church for many years as people have come to know Christ, have put Him on in baptism, then believed themselves "ok" to return back to their former life. There is extreme danger in professing change but not actually following through. Jesus explicitly taught His disciples, "If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me. For whoever would save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it. For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world and forfeits his soul? Or what shall a man give in return for his soul? For the Son of Man is going to come with his angels in the glory of his Father, and then he will repay each person according to what he has done." (Matthew 16:24-27)

Are we living out a true faith that understands our need to be transformed? Or are we trying to hang on to our own selfish desires while professing to be a follower of Christ?
