One of the strengths of Rolling Hills Covenant Church is that we are a multigenerational community that prioritizes discipleship. We believe that one of the best things we can do as a church is to invest in the next generation. The Children's Ministries team and I are so thankful that you have continued to pray for and minister to our children at RHCC this year. Our hope is that we might equip and support families as they raise their children up in the ways of the Lord.

You may know that our Children's Ministries team has gone through a season of transition this past year. We've brought on new staff (myself included), launched new programs, and started using a new curriculum. Change can be refreshing, exciting, and life giving. It can also be uncomfortable. But thankfully, God's Word remains the same. Jesus is still our Savior. And, the Holy Spirit is still guiding us in the will of the Father. I find so much assurance in that truth, because I know that He is leading us in ministering to our youth. I experience joy when I envision what RHCC Children's Ministries could be in a year, five years, or 20 years with our obedience and with His continued leadership.

Here are a couple of exciting things that you can expect in the coming months. This summer, we will begin testing a brand new electronic check-in system. This system will allow our ministries to track data, ease the check-in process for parents, and keep children safer and more secure while they are in our care. Our goal is to fully launch this in September, so please continue to pray for the technology and for our staff as we get the new system up and running.

Each week, we have the privilege of sharing the Gospel with about 400 kids, with over 200 amazing leaders serving in various roles in our classrooms. Our staff have been praying for months that God would bring the right people to serve with us this summer and next year. Whether you have been a leader of kids before or not, I want to invite you to pray about joining our team. It takes a massive amount of leaders to keep all of our programs healthy and thriving, so if you want to do something this year that will truly matter, consider leading a small group of kids. Come find us on the patio after service, we'd love to meet you.

Where is God calling you to invest at RHCC? Is it through serving? Is it through giving? We pray that as you continue to faithfully give your time, talents and resources, that you would continue to look for ways to invest in the next generation at RHCC, so that they may know and love Christ.
