Day 1 June 19, Tuesday: Depart for Ireland

Depart Detroit and Philadelphia International Airports on American Airlines for our overseas journey to Ireland. Complimentary dinner, breakfast and beverages will be served on the flight. (D,B)

Day 2 June 20, Wednesday: Arrive in Shannon | Corrib River Cruise | Westport

Morning arrival at Shannon Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and our Peter's Way Tours tour manager/guide will meet us upon our exit from Customs. Board our comfortable touring bus, and we will be on our way to Galway, the capital of the west, affectionately known as "The City of the Tribes." An independent stop will be made for tea, coffee and scones. Upon arrival in Galway, we will enjoy a Corrib Cruise. The Corrib Princess takes passengers along the majestic River Corrib and onto the lake. During the journey, passengers will have wonderful views of the historic monuments and natural amenities that make this one of the most spectacular waterways in Ireland. Independent lunch. Afternoon check-in at hotel in Westport.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Westport. (B,D)

Day 3 June 21, Thursday: Connemara | Kylemore Abbey | Sung Mass in Knock

Irish breakfast at hotel. This morning, travel through the Connemara Region en route to Kylemore Abbey, a Gothic-style castle built in the 19th century. Today this impressive building belongs to the Benedictine Nuns. Hidden between mountains and a lake, the Abbey is situated in a romantic place of great beauty. Independent lunch. Continue to Knock, an important pilgrimage center and site of apparitions and miraculous cures. Knock Shrine contains a number of churches including the modern Basilica and the Church of the Assumption. In 1879, an apparition of St. Mary, St. Joseph and St. John the Evangelist was recorded, and later recognized as authentic. The special message of Knock is the need for Penance. **Recitation of the Holy Rosary at the Chapel of the Apparition. Celebrate 3:00 pm Mass and blessing of the sick at Knock Shrine Basilica, sung by the Toledo Diocesan Choir.**

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Westport. (B,D)

Day 4 June 22, Friday: Burren Region | Cliffs of Moher | Bunratty Castle

Irish breakfast at hotel. This morning, **transfer to Galway Cathedral for the 11:00 am Mass sung by the Toledo Diocesan Choir.** After Mass, drive through the spectacular Burren Region named after its polished limestone landscape ('Boirean' is the Irish word for rocky). Stop at the Cliffs of Moher, the majestic cliffs in Ireland rising out of the Atlantic Ocean. From this height, and weather permitting, you can see the Aran Islands and Connemara Mountains. Independent lunch. Continue to Limerick for hotel check-in. **This evening, enjoy a Medieval banquet at Bunratty Castle and Folk Park.** You will be greeted by a killed piper, then cross over the drawbridge and join the Earl of Thomond for a festive banquet at this majestic 15th century castle. Enjoy an evening filled with music, excellent food, drink and cheer!

Overnight at hotel in Limerick. (B,D)

Day 5 June 23, Saturday: Dingle Peninsula

Irish breakfast at hotel. This morning, head south through the Dingle Peninsula, famous for its Celtic history, pre-Christian monuments and Christian churches. It is also a 'Gaeltacht' (Irish speaking) area, where the Irish language and traditional ways of life are preserved. Continue towards Inch Beach, made famous by David Lean's movie *Ryan's Daughter*, and admire the Iveragh Peninsula as well as Rossbeigh Beach. Drive around the coast to Sleat Head where the blue of the marine landscape surrounds the Blasket Islands, deserted since 1953. In the distance are the two rocky Skellig islands, where the ruins of an early Christian Monastery can be found. Continue to Dingle town itself, which is a typical country Irish town with colorful buildings, plentiful pubs, narrow streets, a busy harbor, and plenty of opportunity for shopping. Independent lunch and time will be given to explore Dingle town. Late afternoon, we continue to Tralee for hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Tralee. (B,D)

Day 6 June 24, Sunday: Ring of Kerry | Muckcross House | Sung Mass and Recital at St. Mary Cathedral, Killarney

Irish breakfast at hotel. Then we will depart for a highlights tour of the Ring of Kerry, the most famous and panoramic route in Ireland. Take in spectacular scenery - mountains, peat bogs, lakes and magnificent views of the Atlantic Ocean as we travel along the coast road. Leaving Killarney, we will pass through Killorglin, famous for its Puck Fair, and then continue to Glenbeigh where the cliff road affords panoramic views of the Dingle Peninsula and Dingle Bay. Pass the birthplace of national hero Daniel O'Connell, the towns of Waterville and Sneem. The road continues through the mountains to Molls Gap and Ladies View, famous for outstanding views of the Lakes of Killarney. Independent lunch. This afternoon, visit Muckcross House, a magnificent Victorian mansion built in 1843 and is one of Ireland's leading stately homes beautifully situated amidst the spectacular scenery of Killarney National Park. The Gardens of Muckcross House are famed for their beauty worldwide. Late afternoon, **transfer to St. Mary's Cathedral for rehearsal and 6:15pm Mass, followed by a recital, presented by the Toledo Diocesan Choir.**

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Tralee. (B,D)

Day 7 June 25, Monday: Blarney Castle | Waterford

Irish breakfast at hotel. This morning, depart for County Cork to visit Blarney Castle. Kiss the Blarney Stone and gain the gift of eloquence of speech. Stop for shopping at Blarney Woollen Mills, and then on to Waterford, the oldest city in Ireland. A walled city of Viking origin, Waterford retains much of its Medieval character as well as the graceful buildings from its 18th century expansion. Independent lunch upon arrival in Waterford. Visit the House of Waterford Crystal, a fairly new home for Waterford Crystal. The guided tour of the factory includes a visit to all aspects of traditional crystal production including, mold making, glass blowing, quality inspection, finishing, cutting, sculpting and engraving. Late afternoon, **transfer to the Cathedral of the Most Holy Trinity for the 5:30pm Mass sung by the Toledo Diocesan Choir, followed by a recital.** Continue to hotel for check-in.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Waterford. (B,D)

Day 8 June 26, Tuesday: Glendalough | Dublin

Irish breakfast at hotel. After breakfast, we leave for Dublin. En-route we will visit Glendalough, which is tucked away in the Wicklow Hills. Glendalough stands for "the valley of two lakes" and has important monastic ruins. St. Laurence O'Toole, one of the few Irish saints to have been formally canonized, was an abbot and builder of churches here in the 12th century before he became Archbishop of Dublin. St. Kevin, is whom we most associate with Glendalough. He was responsible for the foundation of the monastery, which expanded around his tomb after his death, around 618. The monastery has two foci—one at each of the two lakes in the valley. The upper one is simpler and more austere, evocative of the eremitical side of St. Kevin's life; the lower one has the more famous monuments, one of the best-preserved round towers in the country, the diminutive Priest's House, which is probably the Saint's tomb-shrine. Independent lunch. Continue to Dublin and **arrive in time for the 5:45 pm Mass at St. Mary's Pro-Cathedral, sung by the Toledo Diocesan Choir.** Check-in at hotel in Dublin.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Dublin. (B,D)

Day 9 June 27, Wednesday: Recital at St. Patrick's Cathedral | Highlights of Dublin & Farewell Dinner

Irish breakfast at hotel. This morning we will explore Dublin's "Fair City!" Take in famous sights including the 'Doors of Dublin,' the elegant Georgian squares, and Phoenix Park. A highlight of the tour will be a visit to Trinity College, to view the 8th century illustrated manuscript, *The Book of Kells*, followed by a visit to St. Patrick's Cathedral, made famous by its former dean, Jonathan Swift, author of *Gulliver's Travels*. The cathedral, built in 1213, is the largest in Ireland with a splendid interior adorned with funeral monuments. **12:30 pm rehearsal at St. Patrick's Cathedral followed by 1:00 pm Concert presented by the Toledo Diocesan Choir.** Independent lunch and afternoon at leisure. We recommend a visit to the Guinness Storehouse to see how this famous brewery was established and how the popular black brew is created. Or take a stroll down Grafton Street and enjoy the best in street entertainment and great shopping. **This evening, enjoy dinner and entertainment at The Merry Ploughboy Pub. Enjoy fine food and a lively show featuring contemporary Irish dancing and well-known guest artists.**

Overnight at Hotel in Dublin. (B,D)

Day 10 June 28, Thursday: Return to the USA

After breakfast, we will be transferred by coach to Dublin Airport for our flight home. (B)

PAYMENT: Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order or credit card. **A discount of \$100.00 per person will apply for payments made entirely by personal check, money order or certified bank check.** Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to increase package price or reduce services accordingly should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If final payment is not received by the balance deadline, Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to cancel your reservation. If for any reason payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will apply. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank has returned a personal check, a \$25.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check or credit card.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: From the time your deposit is received up to 130 days prior to departure, there is a \$250.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 129 to 100 days prior to departure, there is a \$350.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, there is a nonrefundable cancellation fee of 100% of all payments made per person including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments and any other costs incurred. Travel insurance is offered as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons such as illness or injury, please see TRAVEL INSURANCE. Travel insurance payments are nonrefundable upon receipt. Tour participation is nontransferable. Names cannot be transferred on reservations or airline tickets. Refund requests can only be honored when submitted in writing to Peter's Way Tours. All refund requests are subject to cancellation restrictions as set forth above. No refund will be made for any accommodations or services included in the tour that you do not use.

LATE RESERVATIONS: A \$25.00 late reservation fee & possible increase in airfare may apply for bookings received after the deposit deadline. All space is subject to availability & cannot be guaranteed past the deposit deadline on brochure.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: All participants must have a valid passport. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least the duration of your visit.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all documents needed are completed and current. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for lack of current and valid entry documents.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round trip on **American from Detroit.** Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Departure taxes & fuel surcharges are estimated. They are determined solely by the airlines and are subject to increase prior to ticketing (*approximately 30 days prior to departure*).

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group airline contracts a block of seats for the group is assigned. Requests for seating preferences may be made at time of check-in. Peter's Way cannot submit seating preferences as we cannot guarantee that any or all requests will be honored. If you require specific seating as a condition of your travel, it is suggested that you book your airfare individually and purchase the Land Only package. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available but oftentimes airlines will not allow the upgrades until time of ticketing (*approximately 30 days prior to departure*). Group reservations may not be accessible online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. Airline guidelines vary. Please contact our office for specific details.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: Land Only packages do not include any portion of the group airfare. This includes any flights booked within the group itinerary. All airline tickets will be your responsibility to book independently. A passenger choosing the Land Only portion of the package (**\$2,295 per person, sharing a twin room**) must notify Peter's Way Tours, in writing, 100 days prior to date of departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport. However, if you arrive at the same time or earlier than your group, you are welcome to join the group on the bus. It is recommended that you purchase your air transportation only after you have been notified that the group has materialized. If you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare or other arrangements booked independently.

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: We are pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for detailed information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: Pricing is based on two persons sharing twin bedded rooms in hotels throughout your tour. Matrimonial (full) bedded rooms are subject to availability and must be requested. Triple rooms may be available for family or friends traveling together. We discourage triple room accommodations because they are normally not spacious and there is no discount for triple occupancy. Triple rooms usually are regular twin or matrimonial (full) bedded rooms with a rollaway bed added. Single rooms are limited but may be requested at time of booking for an additional charge of **\$595.00**. While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin bedded rooms and may be located away from the group in some hotels. We will make every effort (if you so desire) to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Breakfast and dinner daily, including **Medieval banquet at Bunratty Castle, and special dinner show at The Merry Ploughboy.** Beverages (coffee, tea, mineral water) are not included at set menu dinners.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. For good work, recommended (but voluntary) tipping to your tour manager is **4.00 Euro** per passenger per day; to the driver is **2.00 Euro** per passenger per day; **for the local guides 1.50 Euro per passenger per day.** Tips for the tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. Other gratuities are usually handled individually. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave **1.00 Euro** per person for the waiters after each meal and **1.00 Euro** per person per day for the maid/bell boys.

TRAVELER HEALTH ADVISORY: All passengers must ensure that they are medically and physically fit for travel and that such traveling will not endanger themselves or others as our pilgrimages entail a lot of walking, which may involve stairs, hills, cobblestone roads and uneven pavement. Additionally, most motor coaches are not equipped with wheelchair ramps. It is each passenger's responsibility to be aware of his or her limits with regard to travel and group activities. Any person with a disability requiring special attention must advise Peter's Way Tours of the situation at time of enrollment. A qualified companion must accompany any passenger requiring special assistance. Peter's Way Tours will make reasonable attempts to accommodate disabled passengers with special needs, but shall not be held responsible in the event we are unable to do so. Moreover, Peter's Way Tours is not responsible for the denial of services by any carriers, hotels, restaurants, or other independent suppliers.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: It is strongly recommended that all participants purchase insurance when they travel since the tour operator is not responsible for non-refundable payments, damaged luggage or trip interruption. Peter's Way Tours offers an optional Passenger Travel Protection Plan that provides coverage for pre-paid travel arrangements made through Peter's Way Tours. These benefits and services help insure the well being of the passenger while traveling worldwide. The insurance premium is based on total package price, including taxes, fuel surcharges, single supplements, deviation fees, late charges, etc. **The insurance premium for total package prices from \$0 to \$1000.00 is \$100; \$1001.00 to \$2000.00 is \$175; \$2001.00 to \$3000.00 is \$225; \$3001.00 to \$4000.00 is \$250; \$4001.00 to \$5000.00 is \$275; and \$5001.00 and over is 6% of total package price.
