Nurses congratulate winners of special elections

ORLANDO (FL) -- The Florida Nurses Association Political Action Committee (FNPAC) congratulates the primary election winners of special elections held in Senate District 6 and House Districts 17 and 24.

FNPAC endorsed Republican candidate Travis Hutson in the primary election for Senate District 6, as well as Cyndi Stevenson in House District 17 and Paul Renner in House District 24.
