The General Host Corp. sold that building to the Samrus Corp. of Folsom last June for \$85,000. Samrus sold it to Samuel J. Pace of Edystone two months ago for \$100,000. And Pace sold it to the county for \$150,000.

The list of such inconsistencies is endless. The county's botched-up system is probably costing it hundreds of thousands of tax dollars, money that has to be made up by incorrectly assessed taxpayers and higher-than-necessary taxes.

Fair, equitable assessments will come only with a complete county reevaluation by an independent firm.
