I am still proud, and have been recently able to reaffirm that on a vacation where I encountered questions and comments!

This is just to give any word of encouragement that may be welcome. I was much pleased with the extensive coverage that your recent communication gave us all of the situation as it had developed over the long haul, and of the way it had all been handled, and I continue to give my enthusiastic appreciation of your attitude during the whole crisis. Being a long-time advocate of the sort of understanding the college has given to this area of the world's problems, my admiration continues.

Keep it up, and accept my thanks for keeping the liberal approach to the world's affairs as a standard for Swarthmore.
