CHIP Activities

A) Work camps - No work camps have been held since the last meeting. Plans are in the making for a work camp this weekend and all are invited.

C) Conference - A small delegation from CHIP attended a conference on community organization at Dartmouth College, Hanover, New Hampshire on April 1&2, 1966. A report has been drawn up and copies of it are available to anyone who wishes to have one.

D) Publicity - CHIP has been getting good publicity in the newspapers of our area. Articles have appeared in the Inquirer, Daily Times, Afro-American, and the latest in the Phoenix Sunday Supplement, "CHIP Presents Dynamic Programs" appeared April 10.

E) CHIP cooperated with the Red Cross and the Greater Chester Movement in helping fire victims in Chester. The tragic fire took place only half a block from the CHIP office, and many friends of our organization were effected by it.

F) CHIP will have two people from the Swarthmore work-study program working with the organization this summer. This arrangement was made through the Wade House. It is desired by the Director to have at least one of the two Negro.

G) The CHIP three-point attack on community organization began last Saturday, April 16, 1966, with seven organizers going out into the field in the 100 and 200 blocks of Reany Street in an attempt to organize a block group. Follow-up will be taken care of by organizers assigned to that particular area.
