## **Instructions**

**Once you have unpacked your BBQGUYS Fire Pit, carefully set the unit on its side. Install the four adjustable legs by screwing them all the way into the receiving nuts on the bottom corners of the unit. If your patio is not level, adjust legs accordingly.**

**The burner and valve are pre-installed. The burner and burner tray may need to be removed to install the connections to the gas source. Your installer should always check for leaks after hooking up to your gas source. Check for leaks at ALL connection points, no exceptions! Fittings that were preassembled may have come loose during shipment.**

**After your certified plumber or gas specialist hooks your unit up and has safely checked all connections for leaks, spread all eight bags of lava rocks evenly over the burner so that you can not see it.**

**When lighting the unit make sure the valve is in the off position. Use a long match or long lighter to light your fireplace. Once you have the match or lighter ignited, and placed next to the burner, turn the gas on slowly, especially with propane. Propane is more explosive than natural gas.**

**For propane units, a high pressure regulator may be required to reach the desired flame height. Make sure you have your regulator preadjusted and not too high, or bodily injury may occur.**

**NEVER operate in windy conditions, as the wind could blow out the flame, and ther resulting gas flow may lead to personal injury or fire.**

**Always install in an open and well ventilated area. This unit is not intended to be used indoors or underneath roofing or other flammable material.**

**Always remove key for the unit when not in use. All children must be supervised by an adult in and around the unit.**

**Caution: Lava rocks may take several hours to cool after unit is turned off. Never operate unit around flammables, fumes may carry and cause injury or fire.**
