



1. MAKE TWO 2'x8' FLATS WITH 1x4 FRAMES.
2. CONNECT THEM WITH A 30" SPINDLE IN EACH CORNER AS SHOWN.
3. CUT A 16"x84" SHELF FOR THE MIDDLE OUT OF MDF.
4. MOUNT IT ON TWO THICK SPINDLES OR SOME OTHER DECORATIVE LEGS AS SHOWN.
5. THE SHELF AND THESE TWO DECORATIVE SPINDLES WILL BE WHITE.
6. THE REST WILL BE BRIGHTLY COLORED.
7. RUN A DECORATIVE CHAIR RAIL OR OTHER TRIM AROUND THE EDGE OF EACH OF THE TWO FLATS. THIS WILL ALSO HIDE THE EDGES OF THE FABRIC.
8. SWIVEL CASTERS ON THE BOTTOM.
9. THIS UNIT WILL BE FILLED WITH CLEAR CANDY JARS.
10. WE WOULD LIKE TO HAVE THE FRONT AND SIDES FACED INSIDE OF THE SPINDLE CORNERS WITH PLEXI, ACRYLIC, OR SOME OTHER MATERIAL THAT READS LIKE GLASS.
