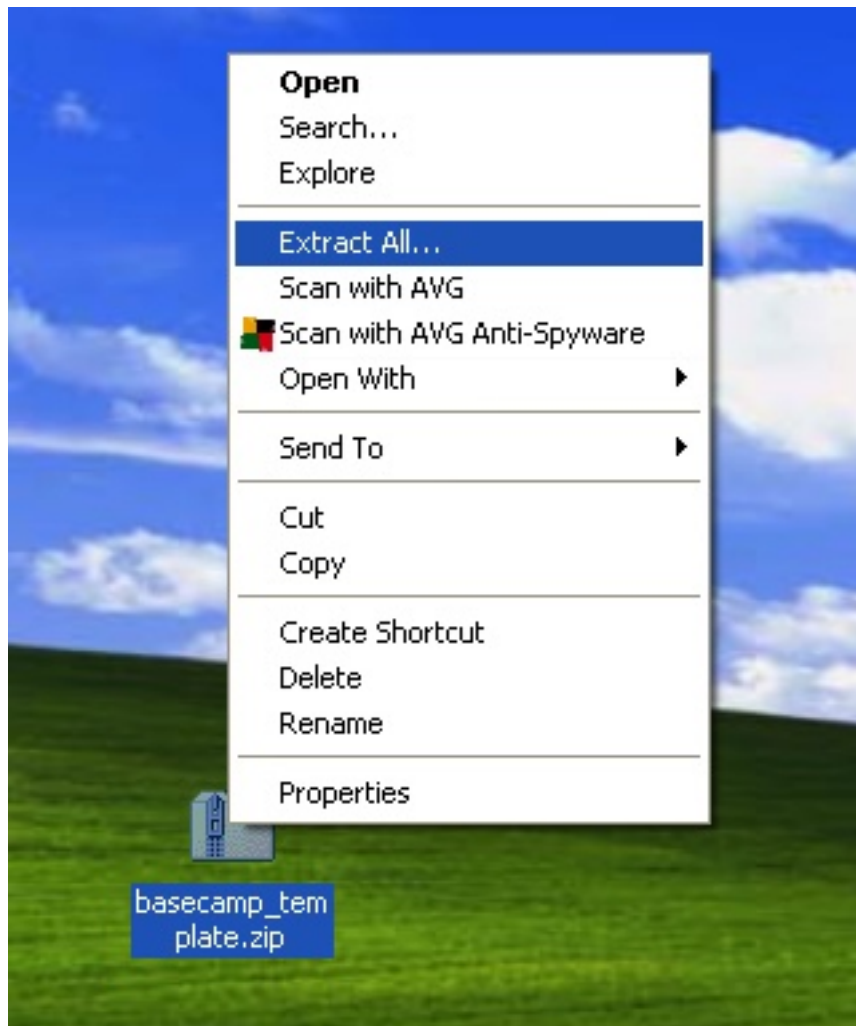

Here are some blog templates that you can use with the Export to Blog feature available in ScreenSteps 2.0.3.

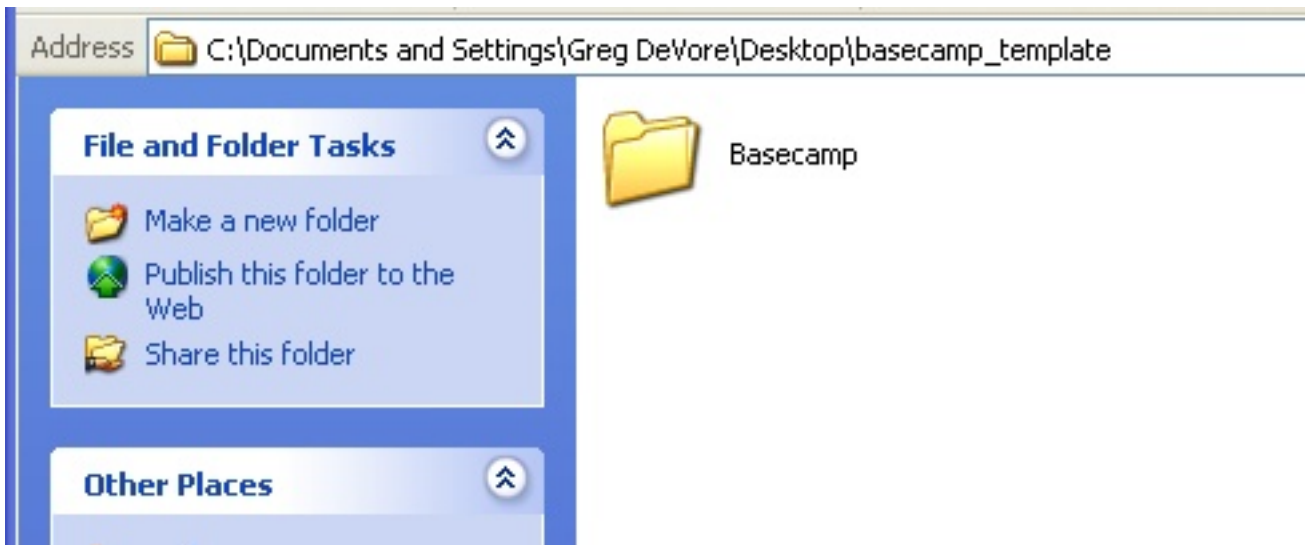

If you are on a Mac the zip file will most likely extract automatically. If you are on a PC then right click on the zip file and select **Extract All**.

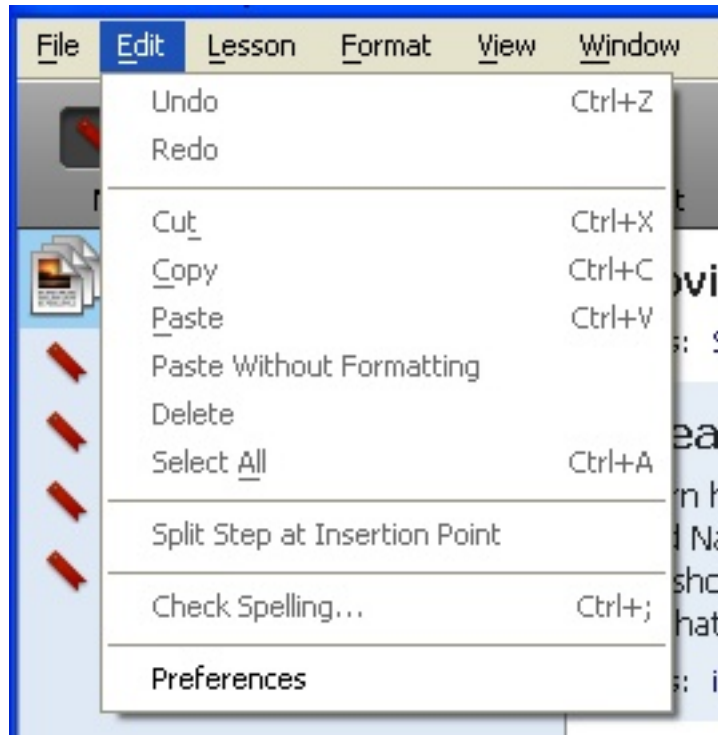


You should now have a "Basecamp" folder.

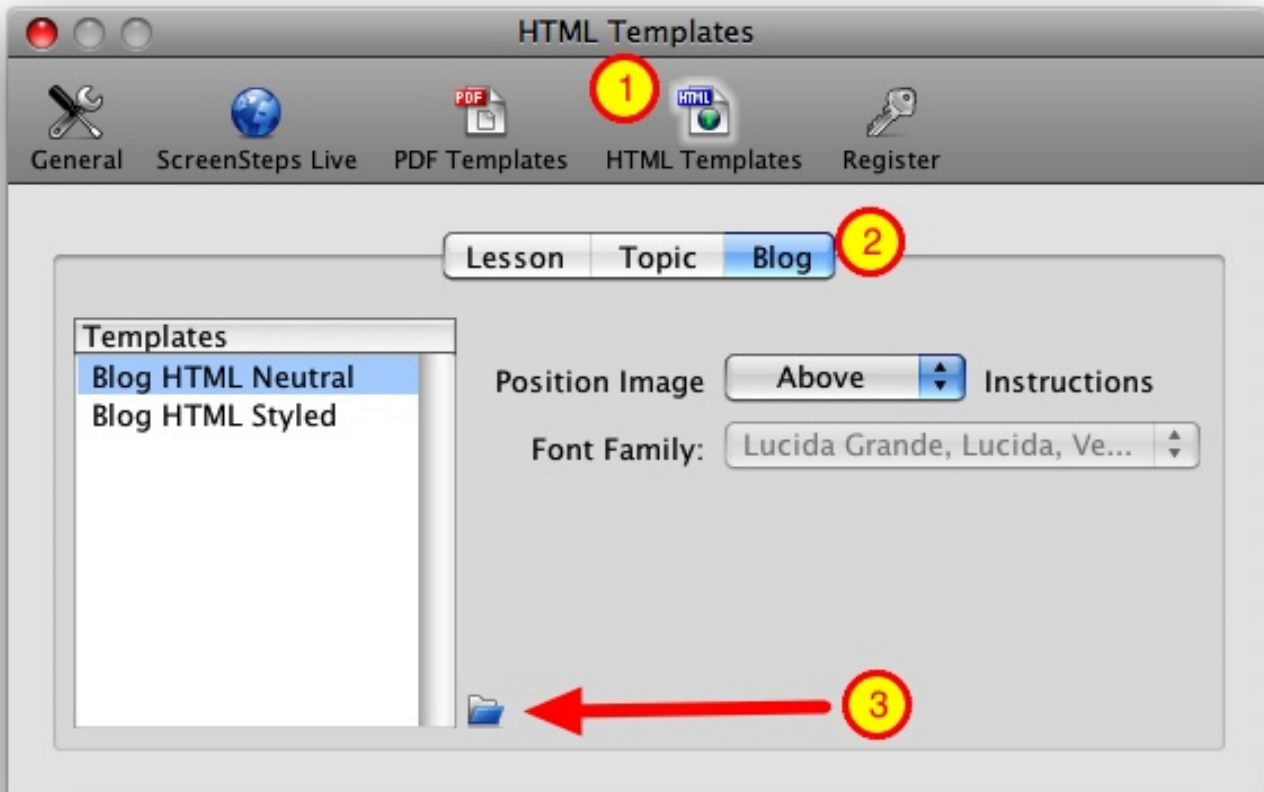
**Open Preferences**



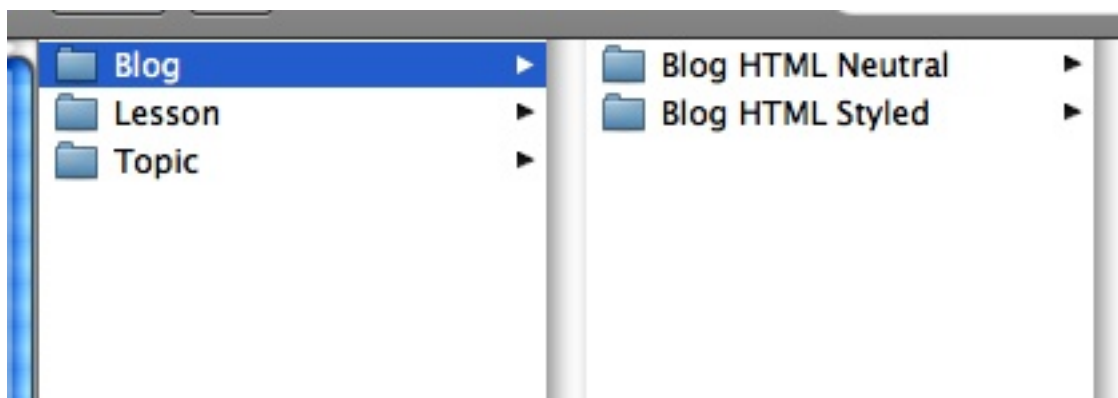
Preferences are in the **ScreenSteps** menu on Mac and in the **Edit** menu on Windows.



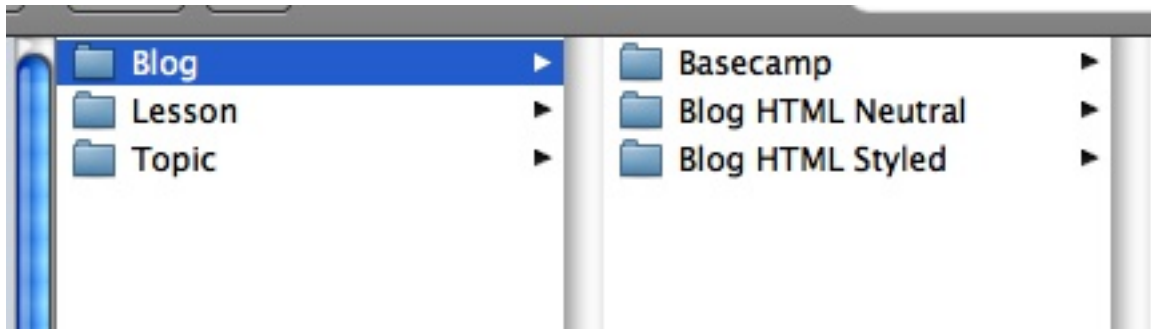
## Open Template Folder



1. Select HTML Templates
2. Select Blog
3. Select Reveal Template Folder



It should look something like this.



Drag the "Basecamp" folder that you just downloaded and extracted into the "Blog" folder. You template is now ready to use.
