This is Tony Thomas, Superintendent of Salina Public Schools. We have just released our Salina Public Schools Re-Entry Plan on our school website and school Facebook pages. The plan was approved at Monday night's Special Board Meeting. We have worked long and hard on this plan to provide the safest environment for your child to return to school and continue their education. We have two options available for you to choose from. We have the Traditional model and the Virtual model. Traditional model will consist of the normal routine as before with extra precautions put in place to help with cleaning and social distancing. Virtual model will consist of the student working online to complete a learning program that will be under the direction of a Salina teacher. In both models, students will be provided a Chromebook or tablet for them to complete their work. We will also provide a Hotspot for internet connection if needed. We encourage you to look over the plan thoroughly and decide what plan is best for your child. We ask that if you should choose the Virtual model that you please contact the building principal immediately to let them know that you prefer the Virtual model of Learning at this time. If you enroll in the Virtual model, you will have to stay in that model for the entire semester before changing back to the Traditional model.
