

 The Madison Parish School District Title One Services is a federally funded program. Title X McKinney Vento Act is the homeless services component in which the district provides uniforms, school supplies and other services to individuals identified as being homeless. These services are provided to families that have school age children. 



 The Title 1 Office will begin taking applications on September 1, 2020. We are located at Wright Elementary School on the 2nd floor south wing. Applications will be taken on Tuesday – Thursday from 9:00 A.M. – 11:00 A.M. and 1:00 P.M. – 3:00 P.M. Please call the office to schedule an appointment to complete applications due to COVID-19 pandemic. Please wear a mask upon entering the building and continue to wear the mask at all times for safety precautions. 

 Definition of Homeless 

 *Children and Youth who are sharing the housing of other persons due to loss of housing, economic hardships, or similar reasons; are living in motels, hotels, trailer parks, or camping grounds due to lack of alternative adequate accommodations; are living in emergency or transitional shelters; are abandoned in hospitals; or are waiting foster care placement; 

 *Children and Youth who have a primary nighttime residence that is a public or private place not designed for ordinary use as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings; 

 *Children and Youth who are living in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus station, or similar settings; and migratory children.
