

The Serendipity Club Scholarship

The object of the Serendipity Club is to stimulate intellectual and cultural development, to promote and assist in civic enterprises, to do what we can for the betterment of humanity and to promote fellowship among our members.

It is with great pleasure that Serendipity has chosen to give an annual scholarship to a young woman who plans to attend a two or four-year college or university.

Requirements for the **senior** applicants include:

- Female
- Possessing a B average (85 or above)
- Financial need
- Enroll in a 2-4 year college or university as a full time student (12 or more hours)
- Must attend school the fall semester immediately following graduation
- The personal motivation for scholastic and professional excellence

The **\$1000** scholarship will be presented by the president of Serendipity at the high school awards assembly in May. The senior girl will receive a check for \$500 payable to the student and the school of her choice prior to the first semester, and a second check for \$500 given at the beginning of the second semester. The recipient must provide proof of enrollment each semester to the Serendipity Club in order for the checks to be disbursed. Both checks are to be used within twelve months.

The Serendipity Scholarship Committee will serve as the selection board.

Serendipity Scholarship applications are available through the office of the high school guidance counselor and the PHS scholarship website. They should be completed and returned to the high school guidance counselor. Applications must be typed in order to be considered.

Deadline for this scholarship is **April 1**.
